What is the Missouri Workers' Safety Program?

The Missouri Workers' Safety Program (MWSP) was created by Missouri statute in 1992. The program's mission is to help Missouri employers:

- Improve workplace safety
- Reduce workers' compensation cost;
- Regulate safety services provided by insurance carriers.

What assistance can I receive from the MWSP?

The program's goal is to help employers eliminate fatalities and reduce the number and severity of injuries in Missouri's workplaces.

We offer:

- Free on-site safety and health reviews conducted by our staff of safety professionals
- Advice on workers' compensation insurance, experience modification, classifications, rates, reserves, choice of physician, and ways to reduce premiums
- Safety videos loaned at no charge
- A list of independent safety consultants and engineers certified by the MWSP

What about OSHA?

The MWSP does not:

- Make reports or referrals to OSHA
- Cite, fine, or penalize employers in any way

What workplace safety assistance can I receive from my insurance carrier?

Missouri Workers' Compensation law requires all workers' compensation insurance carriers to make comprehensive safety engineering and management services available to their insured employers upon request.
